May we step forward not as one lacking faith in the future, but with confidence, courage, and assurance of a better, brighter, and more prosperous future.

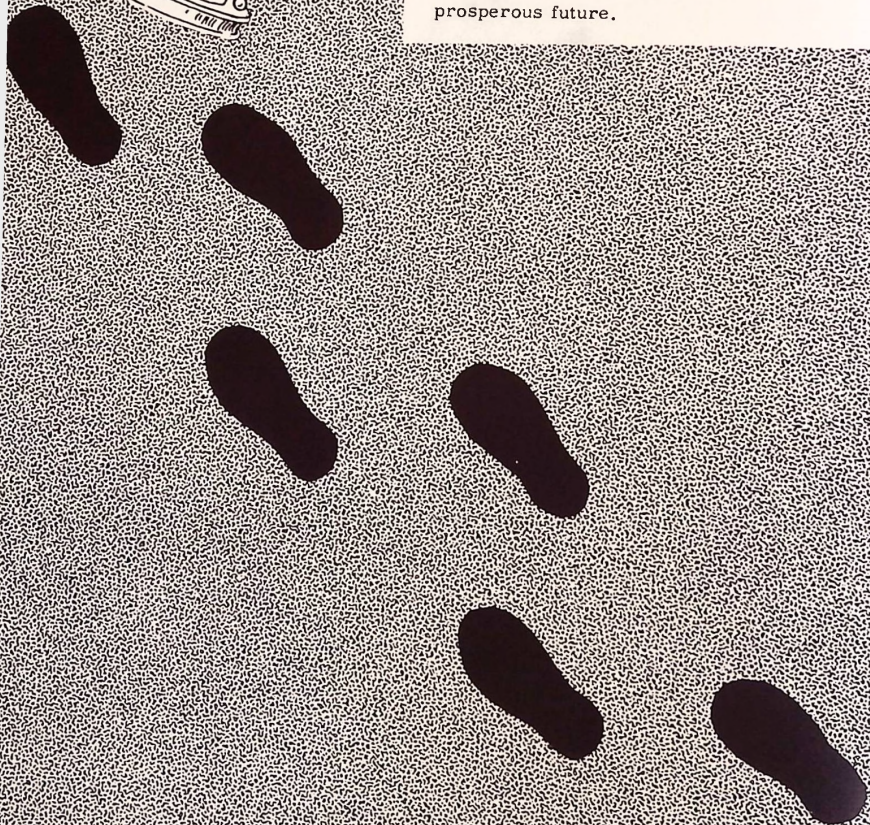
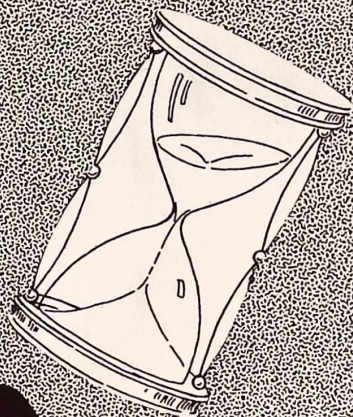
